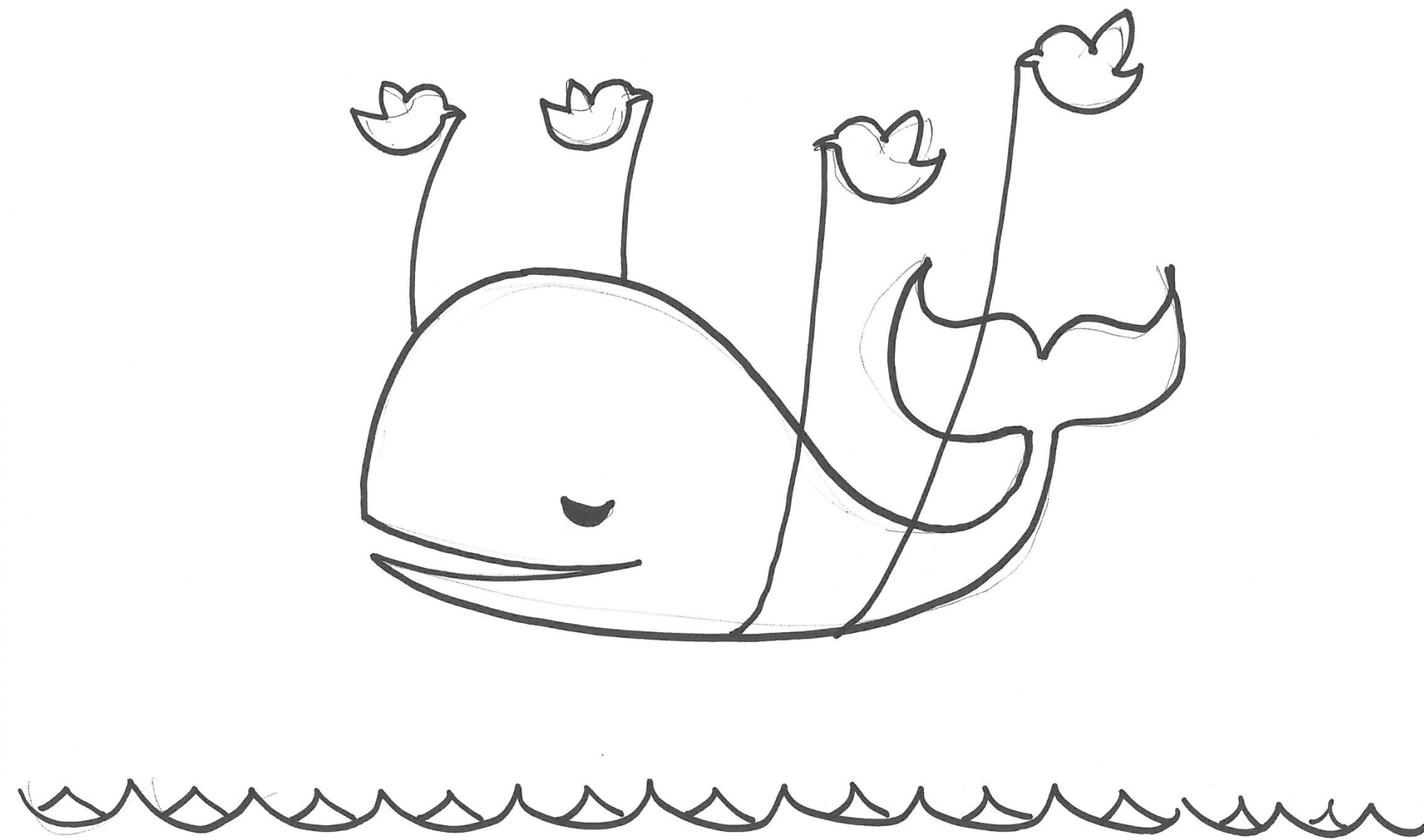


Communicate clear affordances

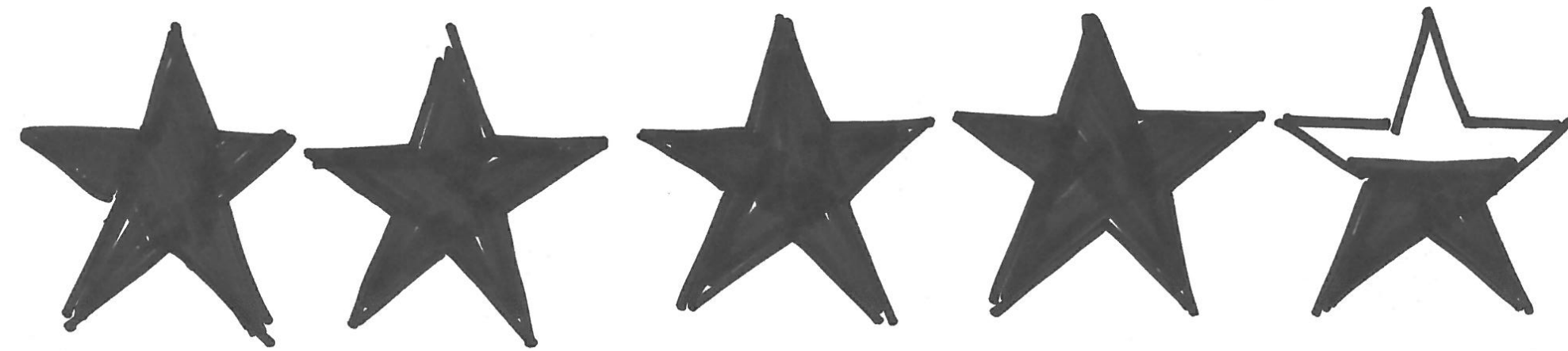


Visibility of system status

People seek guidance from domain experts.

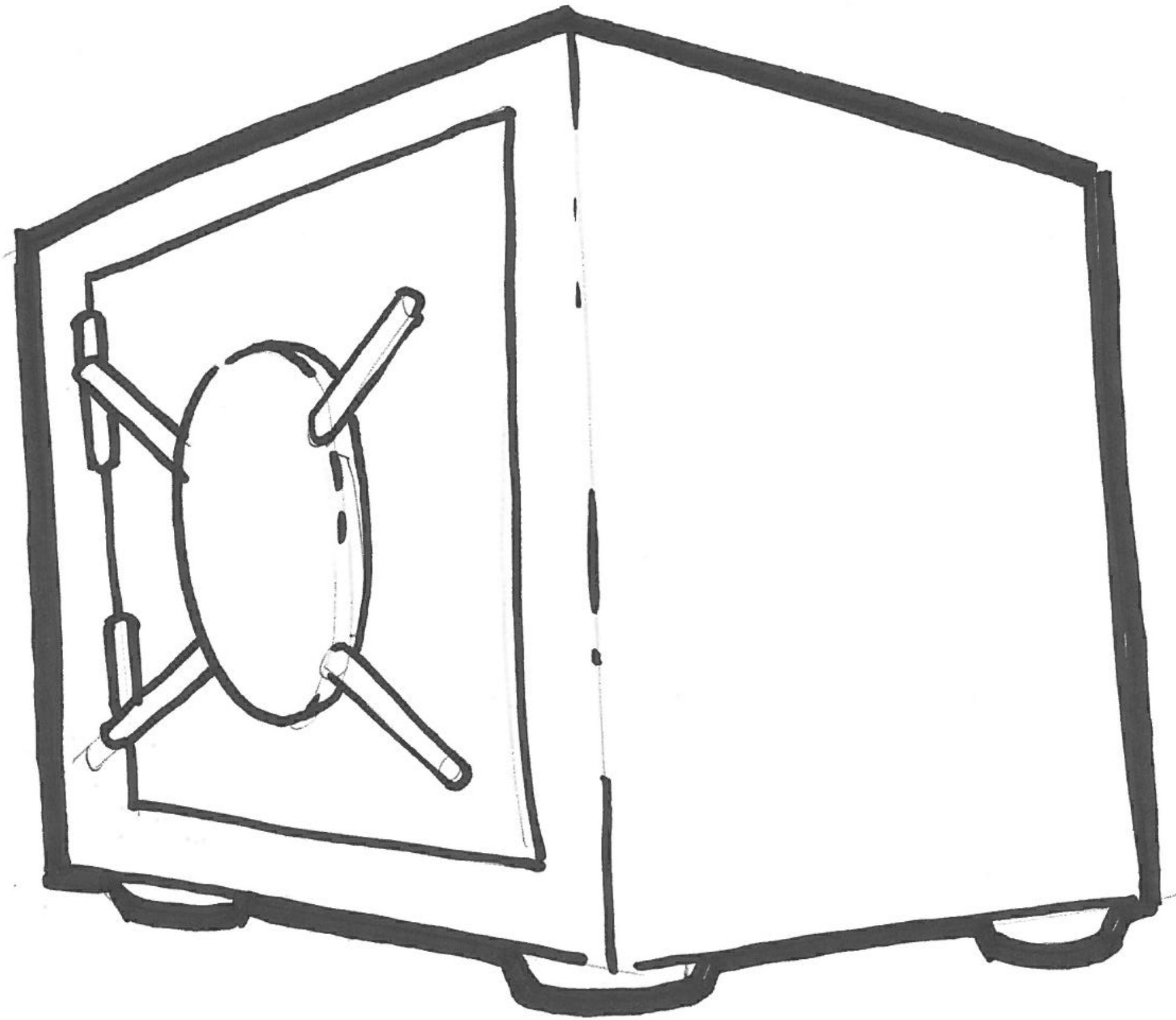


Facilitate social proof

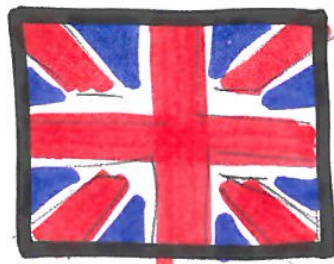
